ORDINANCE NO: 2020-O-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO.: 2019-O-05 FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE FISCAL OFFICER AND OPERATOR OF RECORD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 731.13 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that the legislative authority of a village shall fix the compensation of all officers, clerks and employees of the village. The legislative authority shall, in the case of elective officers, fix their compensation for the ensuing term of office at a meeting held not later than five days prior to the last day fixed by law for filing as a candidate for such office; and

WHEREAS; the compensation was previously fixed by Ordinance No. 2019-O-05; and

WHEREAS, Village Council wishes to adjust the compensation range of the Fiscal Officer; and

WHEREAS, Village Council further wishes to fix the compensation for the Operator of Record.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH FAIRFIELD, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

SECTION 1. That Section 2 of Village of North Fairfield Ordinance No.: 2019-O-05 is hereby amended as follows:

*Fiscal Officer: \$800.00 to 2000.00 per month.
Paid from the Clerk Salary Account, General Fund, 50% and the Salaries-Administrator's Office Account, Water Fund 50%.*

*Operator of Record: Up to 1,200.00 per month.
Paid from Salaries-Administrator's Office Account, Water Fund.*

SECTION 3. REPEAL. Any part of Ordinance 2019-O-05 inconsistent herewith is hereby rescinded and repealed.

SECTION 4. DISPENSE WITH THREE READINGS. [R.C. 731.17(A)(2)] That the legislative authority, upon a vote of at least three-fourths of its members, hereby dispenses with the rule requiring each ordinance or resolution shall be read on three different days.

SECTION 5. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT. That

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by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to RC 731.30, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s): ***The immediate effectiveness of this ordinance is necessary to provide the continued and uninterrupted operations of the Village.***

SECTION 6. PUBLIC MEETING. It is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution/Ordinance were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


WHEREFORE, this Ordinance/Resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
