***IN THE MATTER OF DETERMINING EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT SERVICE FOR THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH FAIRFIELD***

**WHEREAS**, the Council of Village of North Fairfield is empowered to determine Emergency Management service for the Municipality, pursuant to ORC 5915, as amended by H.B. 131; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of Village of North Fairfield have determined the following:

X To contract with the Huron County Emergency Management Agency for emergency management services, at a cost of \$.25 per person, based on the population of the political subdivision for the period of July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2023. This contract will be renewable on an annual basis. Additionally, the Council of Village of North Fairfield has selected the following individual as their contact person to work with the Huron County Emergency Management Agency effect and serve on the Huron County Emergency Management Advisory Board effective July 1, 2022:
