PERMANENT ANNUAL APPROPRIATION MEASURE

2024 RC 5705.38

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF <u>NORTH FAIRFIELD</u> DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 20<u>24</u>.

WHEREAS, Section 5705.38(A) of the Ohio Revised Code provides that on or about the first day of each fiscal year, the taxing authority of each subdivision shall pass an appropriation measure, and thereafter during the year it may pass any supplemental appropriation measures as it finds necessary, based on the revised tax budget or the official certificate of estimated resources or amendments of the certificate; and

WHEREAS, Section 5705.38(C) of the Ohio Revised Code further provides that appropriation measures shall be classified so as to set forth separately the amounts appropriated for each office, department, and division, and, within each, the amount appropriated for personal services.

WHEREAS, Ohio R.C. 705.18 provides that an annual appropriation ordinance shall be prepared by the legislative authority of a municipal corporation from estimates submitted by the mayor. The annual appropriation ordinance shall be submitted to the legislative authority at its first meeting after the beginning of the municipal corporation's fiscal year, and the total of any appropriation ordinance passed by such legislative authority shall not exceed the total balances carried over from the previous fiscal year plus the estimated revenue of the current fiscal year.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT <u>ORDAINED</u> BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF <u>NORTH</u> <u>FAIRFIELD</u>, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

<u>SECTION 1</u>: That to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village during fiscal year ending <u>December 31, 2024</u>, the following sums are hereby set aside and appropriated as <u>ATTACHED HERETO AND INCORPORATED HEREIN BY REFERENCE</u>.

SECTION 2: That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the Council authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution for Council to make expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or Ordinance. Provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of
