CERTIFICATION OF TAX LEVIES  
*ORC 5705.34*

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

*Rev. Code, Sec.5705.34, 5705.35*

WHEREAS, this council in accordance with the provisions of law has previously adopted a Tax Budget for the next succeeding fiscal year commencing January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025; and

WHEREAS, The Budget Commission of Huron County, Ohio, has certified its action thereon to this Council together with an estimate by the County Auditor of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by this Council, and what part thereof is without, and what part within the ten mill limitation; and

WHEREAS, Each taxing authority, by ordinance or resolution, shall authorize the necessary tax levies and certify them to the county auditor before the first day of October in each year, or at such later date as is approved by the tax commissioner pursuant to ORC 5705.34.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH FAIRFIELD, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

SECTION 1. RESOLVED, By the Council of the Village of NORTH FAIRFIELD, Huron County, Ohio, that the amounts and rates, as determined by the Budget Commission in its certification, be and the same are hereby accepted; and be it further

SECTION 2. RESOLVED, that there be and is hereby levied on the tax duplicate of said Village the rate of each tax necessary to be levied within and without the ten mill limitation as follows:

**SECTION 5. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT.** That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this legislation is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to RC 731.30, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s):

*Certification to the county auditor is due before the first day of October.*

WHEREFORE, this legislation shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
